*Distance: 10-15 minutes by car or motorbike.*
  5. **Chua Ba Thien Hau (Chùa Bà Thiên Hậu)**  
A beautiful Chinese temple dedicated to the sea goddess, known for its stunning architecture and peaceful atmosphere.  
*Distance: 10-15 minutes by car or motorbike.*
  6. **Oriental Medicine Street (Phố Đông Y)**

*Distance: 10-15 minutes by car or motorbike.*
- 4. Notre Dame Cathedral (Nhà Thờ Đức Bà)**  
This neo-Romanesque cathedral is one of the most significant landmarks in Ho Chi Minh City. It's a serene escape from the busy streets.  
*Distance: 15-20 minutes by car or motorbike.*

*Distance: 5-10 minutes by car or motorbike.*

*Distance: 15-20 minutes by car or motorbike.*

1. **SC VivoCity Mall**

*Distance: 15-20 minutes by motorbike or car.*

Ho Chi Minh City offers various transportation options, from motorbike taxis (xe ôm) for quick and convenient trips to traditional taxis and Grab (ride-hailing service) for more comfort. Walking is an excellent option for exploring nearby areas, especially in District 1, where many attractions are within walking distance of each other. Public transportation such as buses is also available but may take longer due to traffic.
